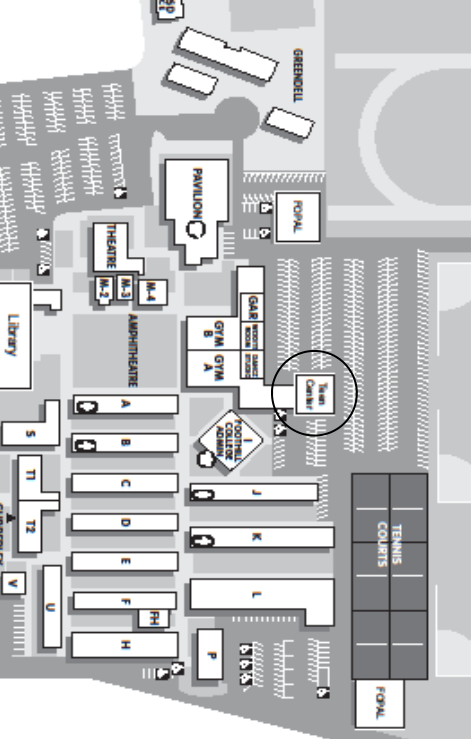


MESSAGE FROM THE STAFF

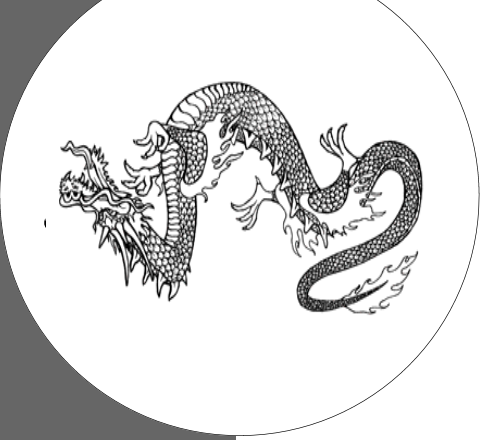
